



<b>Adams County Targeted Problem – Detailed Version</b>	
<b>Child Impact</b>	<b>Not all young children are developing positively</b>
Child Impact Outcomes (ITP)	<b>Not all children are meeting benchmarks/kindergarten readiness measures for language and literacy development.</b> Proxy: The percentage of 3rd graders scoring that met the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) for ELA is lower than the state in 4 of 5 school districts in Adams County in 2022. The data range in 2022 varies from 7.1% in Payson CUSD 1 to 24.8% in CUSD 4. The data compares 25.4% in Illinois in 2022. <b>80% of schools in Adams County are not meeting benchmarks for language and literacy development in 2022.</b>
Child Early Success Outcomes (HB)	<b>Many mothers use harmful substances during pregnancy.</b> Proxy: The percent of mothers who stopped smoking FCM/WIC is 47.4% in 2020 in Adams County. The data is 15% lower than the states percent of 62.4% in 2020. The data range increases from 44.8% in 2019 to 47.4% in 2020.
Family Early Success Outcomes	<b>More families are experiencing food insecurity.</b> Proxy: The percentage of children enrolled in public schools that are eligible for free or reduced-price lunch is 53% in 2021 in Adams County. The data is 4% higher than the states percent of 49% in 2021. The data range varies from 45% in 2019 to 53% in 2021.
