The data is 18.3 higher than the state's rate of 19.4 in 2019.</li> <li>• Rate of Children (0-17) Alleged and Indicated Victims of Abuse and Neglect age 5 and under per 1,000 is 24.97 in <b>Carroll County</b> in 2019. The data is 5.6 higher than the state's rate of 19.4 in 2019.</li> <li>• Rate of Children (0-17) Alleged and Indicated Victims of Abuse and Neglect age 5 and under per 1,000 in <b>Jo Daviess County</b> in 2019. <b>Child Early Success Outcomes (ITP)</b>	<p><b>Not all children are receiving developmental screenings.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The percentage of children 36 to 60 months reported as screened in Child Find is 7.23% in <b>Stephenson County</b> in 2021. The number of screenings decreased from 179 in 2019 to 127 in 2021.</li> <li>• The percentage of children 36 to 60 months reported as screened in Child Find is 0.83% in <b>Carroll County</b> in 2020. The number of screenings decreased from 115 in 2019 to 4 in 2020. There is no data available for 2021.</li> <li>• The percentage of children 36 to 60 months reported as screened in Child Find is 1.57% in <b>Jo Daviess County</b> in 2021. The data decreased from 88 in 2019 to 10 in 2021.</li> </ul>
