Southeast Chicago AOK Network Targeted Problem – Detailed Version	
Child Impact	Not all young children are healthy
Child Impact Outcomes (ITP)	<p>Fewer children are at a healthy weight. <u>Proxy:</u> Percent of adults who reported a height and weight that yield a body mass index of 30 or greater is 46.9% in 2022 in South Chicago (46.9%) East Side (60.6%) Hegewisch (37.5%) compared to state's (32.0%) and City of Chicago's (33.2%) in 2022.</p>
Child Early Success Outcomes (HB)	<p>More babies are born to teen mothers. <u>Proxy:</u> Number of births per 1,000 female population ages 15-19 is 178 in 2020 in South Chicago (178) South Deering (84) East Side (107) Hegewisch (31) compared to the state's percent of 19 in 2020.</p> <p>Not all pregnant women begin prenatal care during the first trimester. <u>Proxy:</u> Percent of births where mother received adequate prenatal care by the Adequacy of Prenatal Care Utilization Index (APNCU) in 2019 in South Chicago (52.4%), South Deering (59.6%) compared to the state's percent of 75.8% and Chicago's percentage of 65.3%</p>
Family Early success Outcomes	<p>More families are experiencing food insecurity. <u>Proxy:</u> Percent of residents who have low access to food, defined solely by distance: further than 1/2 mile from the nearest supermarket in an urban area, or further than 10 miles in a rural area in South Chicago (25.4%), South Deering (70.8%), and Hegewisch (30.9%) compared to the state's (21.9%) and to Chicago's (21.9%) in 2019.</p> <p>Not all families report being healthy and engage in health promoting behaviors. <u>Proxy:</u> Percent of adults who reported that they did not participate in any physical activities or exercises in the past month is 37.9% in 2022 in South Chicago, 37.9% in Hegewisch and 33.7% in East Side. The data is 15.9% higher compared to the state's percentage (22%) and Chicago's percentage (26.1%) in 2022.</p>
